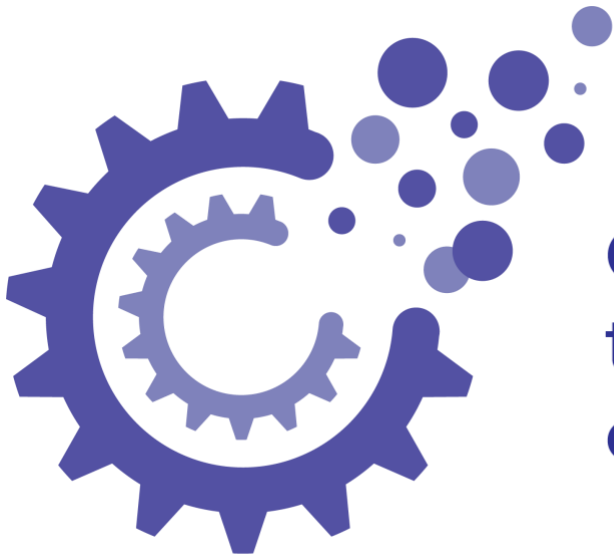




Creativity tools

Report from Hosting Organization Training Course



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Summary of the Training course

Creativity Training course for youth workers was held on 21-23/6/2022 in the premises of the Developmental Center of Thessaly in Trikala, Greece.

In total 15 young participants participated to the training course.

Objectives of the Training course

1. Understand the NEET situation in each partner country
2. Understand Learning Management Systems and eLearning in 2022
3. Learn to use ICT tools to create rich and interactive training material
4. Learn to use online digital collaboration tools

And of course

- Learn methods and tools that can support, teach and empower NEETs to develop their businesses or ideas and access the labour market

Profile of participants

Participants from Italy, Greece, the Czech Republic and Spain were young, the majority being between 18 and 25 years old. Most are studying (Medicine, English literature, Computer Science etc) while some have just finished school and are waiting to see what they will do with their studies. Some work occasionally (mainly as English teachers, office assistants, etc.). The common element of all participants is their anxiety for their future rehabilitation.

Methodology

The methodology used during the training had as its main purpose the involvement and maximum engagement of all participants. For this reason, educational techniques of adult education were used, such as brainstorming, questions-answers, case study, role play as well as the division into groups.

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Summary (explanation for each sessions and the results of the session)

Initially, a presentation was made about the situation of NEETs in each country, their particularities as well as the needs of youth workers.

Then there was an extensive presentation of learning management systems, their advantages and their use, how everyone can create their own digital lesson as well as how they can help and empower NEETs develop their business and access the labour market.

A small workshop was also held in this session where the participants, divided into groups, worked on such a training platform.

There was also a presentation of various tools that allow us to create video-based educational material and digital content in general as well as the benefits of microlearning. Especially nowadays when the attention span of younger people has decreased a lot.

Finally, there was an extensive presentation of the different and most popular Content Management Systems as well as various digital communication and collaboration tools. Again, the main objective and the expected results for the participants in that training is to teach them methods and tools that can support, teach and empower NEETs to develop their businesses or ideas and access the labour market.

Impact (participants and organizations)

The expected impact regarding the participants (but for organizations as well), is for them to learn methods and tools that can support, teach and empower NEETs to develop their businesses or ideas and access the labour market.

Also, the organizations learned the situation prevailing in each country regarding the young people, the different needs they may have. This whole process has provoked discussions and discussions among the participants and the organizations respectively regarding the solutions that can be given to this serious problem that is facing the whole of Europe.

Finally, this training activity inspired the participating organizations for new future collaborations both under the Erasmus+ and in general
